## PSHE

## PE

Geography:


### How do we impact on our landscape?

Children will be researching and gaining knowledge on biomes, vegetation belts, land use, economic activity, distribution of resources, and its effect on landscapes.

They will also be learning about their own surroundings, including general knowledge of countries and counties in the UK.

## Literacy

- King Kong – Using film and book stimulus by Antony Browne, children will be writing newspaper articles, non chronological reports and narrative writing to kick start the pupils' imagination.
- Guided reading will be interlinked with this exciting story.
- The children will also be studying a variety of different poems linked to the topic of our natural environment.



## ICT

- Children will learn to understand computer networks including the internet.
- They will use logical reasoning to explain simple algorithms.
- Design, write and debug programs.
- Use search technologies effectively to research and explore the wonderful technological world we live in!

## Numeracy

- Following Southwark planning
- Children will be working their way through all the key skills in mathematics starting with place value, number facts and calculation, followed by shape and space and then moving through to measurement.
- Daily mental maths and calculation work will take place in addition to the numeracy lesson.

## Art and Design

Studying artists that mastered the art of landscape such as J.M. W Turner, children will experiment with many mediums to create their masterpieces of their own.

Following on from this, children will venture outside to create natural artwork inspired by artists such as Andy Goldsworthy.

## Science

Children are beginning to study the human body! Looking at bones, muscles and vessels, they will feel like real scientists. Becoming masters of their own bodies and even touching on how animals are different or similar to us.
