Phonics

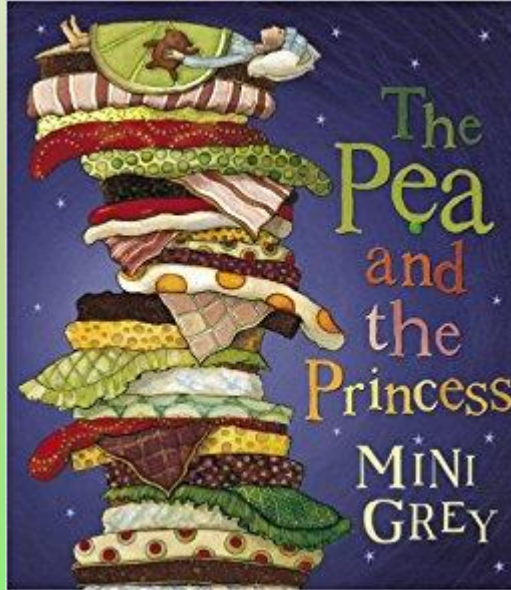
- Revising phase 5 of Letters and Sounds

- Identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials for particular uses.
- Describe objects by their composite material and their properties (e.g. a rigid ruler made of wood).
- Compare suitability of materials for different uses and explain why
- Devise, conduct and record an experiment to investigate the suitability of a material for a purpose

- Practicing strategies to develop and maintain optimism
- Appreciating happy experiences

Design Technology

- Explore a variety of healthy fruits
- How to use everyday cutlery safely and effectively
- How to improve the taste, texture and appearance of fruit
- To evaluate a project

Numeracy

- SATs preparation
- Use place value to solve missing number problems as well as to support mental strategies
- Recall multiplication facts for 2x, 3x, 5x and 10x tables as well as related division facts
- Solve word problems using all four operations (+, -, x, ÷)
- Use standard units of measurement for length, weight and volume
- Interpret and answer questions about tables and diagrams
- Using different coins to make the same amount

PE

- A mixture of athletics and games
- Each lesson will be built around a scenario that will focus on a different aspect of physical development culminating in teamwork
- To perform dances using simple movement patterns
- Explore dance elements of body, space, time shape, movement and energy

History
