## Literacy

- Plan, write and edit our own Greek Myths.
- Develop our spelling rules and conventions knowledge.
- Develop further our understanding of clauses (main, subordinate, relative, embedded and multi-clause sentences) and the supporting punctuation that accompanies them.
- Use a range of sentence types and lengths for dramatic effect and adjust the pace of our texts.
- Build sentence and paragraph cohesion.
