Well done to our own Mr Longman who has achieved Rock Star status! Can you beat his time of 2.1 seconds per question?

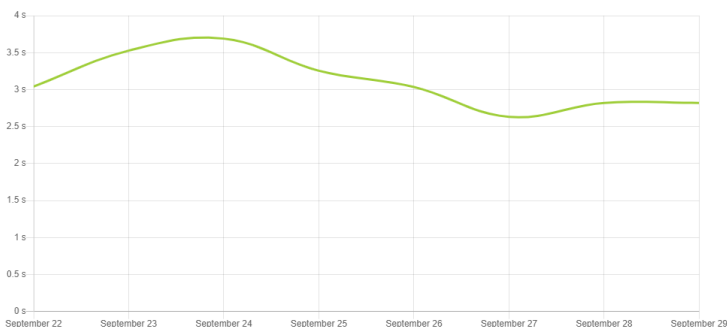
