

<p>Maths</p>	<p>This week we are going to be learning about sharing. Watch the sesame street video about sharing: https://youtu.be/KTFJ9gjfAXg</p> <p>What is sharing 'fairly'? What does it mean to share something fairly? Can you practice sharing with your adult? Choose some toys and share one at a time – are they shared fairly? How do you know?</p>	<p>You will need to choose TEN objects for sharing today – go and choose your favourite toys.</p> <p>Can you use your maths number cards from last week and say each number name out loud? Turn all of the cards over so that you cannot see the numbers. Choose one card- which number did you get? Can you count out that many toys? Can you share that number of toys with your adult? Are they shared fairly? Are there any left over?</p>	<p>Today we are going to set up a picnic for you and TWO friends – choose two teddies to join you! You will need THREE plates or bowls and a selection of food (real or pretend) for your picnic.</p> <p>Can you share THREE pieces of food for your picnic – does everyone have a piece of food? How many bits of food does everyone have? Is it shared fairly?</p> <p>Can you do this with SIX, NINE and then FOUR pieces of food.</p>	<p>Play a maths game! There are lots to choose from. <p>Mindfulness/ Wellbeing</p>	<p>Hot Chocolate Breathing Practise holding your imaginary cup of hot chocolate, breath in deeply and blow the steam away. Do this for 30 seconds. How do you feel?</p> 	<p>5 Senses Can you name: 5 things you can see 4 things you can feel 3 things you can hear 2 things you can smell 1 thing you can taste</p>	<p>Practise 'Take 5' breathing Hold your hands out and spread your fingers. With the finger of the other hand, trace the outline of a finger breathing in through your nose as you trace up. Breathing out through your mouth as you trace down. Keep going at a steady pace.</p> 	<p>One Minute Mindful Eating Take a minute to focus on smells around you. It might be when there is cooking going on or when you are going for a walk. Focus on how many different smells you can identify. How did they make you feel? Did you have a favourite smell?</p>	<p>Pencil Disco Take a pencil and hold it above a piece of paper. Play some music and close your eyes. As the music plays, allow the hand holding the pencil to move across in time with the music. Take a look at your creation!</p> 
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
