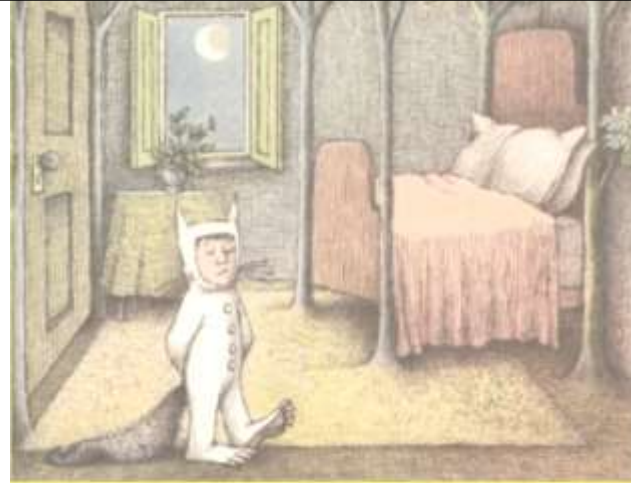


Look at these four pictures of Max' bedroom. Look what happens in each picture. Talk about what is happening. It will help you write some descriptive sentences.
