Using your cards, can you choose 3 sounds to make a word and then blend the sounds together to read? – Remember this could be a 'real word' that we know, like c-a-t or it would be a 'nonsense word' that isn't real, like k-i-r. How many words can you make with these sounds?</p>	<p>Sing along with the phonics song! https://youtu.be/saF3-fOXWAY</p> <p>Using the sound cards you made yesterday, pick 3 sounds at a time to make a simple CVC word – can you write a list of these words in your exercise book?</p> <p>Challenge: Can you write sound buttons on each sound in your word?</p> <p>Remember! After a minute, write down all the sounds you heard.</p>	<p>Teddy Bear Belly Breathing</p> <p>Lie with your back on the floor and put a soft toy on your belly. Breathe in and out slowly. Try and concentrate on the way your toy rises and falls with your breathing.</p> 	<p>Happiness Flower</p> <p>Can you draw a simple flower and fill the petals with things that make you feel happy?</p> 	<p>Helping Others</p> <p>Help someone at home without them asking you. How does this make you feel?</p>	<p>One Minute Mindful Feeling</p> <p>Close your eyes and think about how you are feeling. Which word would you use? Happy? Sad? Excited? Nervous?
