Remember each sound has one sound button. Be sure to say the sound when you draw on the button! (an adult may need to write these words out in your exercise book for you first)</p> <p>Sat Pat Cat Mat Rat Bat Tap Map</p> <p>Here is an example:</p> <p>t i n ... </p>	<p>Sing along with the phonics song! https://youtu.be/saF3-f0XWAY</p> <p>Using your CVC words from yesterday's learning, press your sound buttons to say each sound. Gradually do this a little faster each time until you can hear the sounds coming together. Can you blend these sounds to read the word? What does it say? Read all of the words</p> <p>Don't forget to use your letter formation booklets to practice writing your letter sounds!</p>	<p>Sing along with the phonics song! https://youtu.be/saF3-f0XWAY</p> <p>Using the words that you read yesterday, can you read them again – use the sound buttons if you need to! Can you draw a picture of each of the words you read?</p> <p>Challenge: can you have a go at writing a caption to match your picture e.g. 'tap the cat'</p> <p>Play I-spy with an adult – what can you see around you? Can you use the initial sound to give a clue? E.g. eye spy with my little eye, something beginning with ssssss (sock). Let your adult have a go and see if you can guess what they can see!</p>	<p>Sing along with the phonics song! https://youtu.be/saF3-f0XWAY</p> <p>Sound recap. Find yourself a newspaper, magazine or book and find as many words that use ANY of our phonics sound! How many can you find? <p>Maths</p>	<p>Get yourself a dice for today's maths learning. Can you look at all sides and identify the numbers? If you do not have a dice at home, you can use this one: Online dice</p> <p>Roll the dice and identify the number. Can you find and count that many objects – it can be any object you like, toys, shoes, marbles etc. Make sure you are just counting one object at a time – touch each one to help with this. Be sure to say a number name for each object! Repeat this until you have made a set for each number on the dice.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you write the number for each set?</p>	<p>You will need to use the dice from yesterday's learning.</p> <p>Today we are going to begin to 'add' sets together.</p> <p>+ have a look at this sign. What do you think it means? Talk to your adult about what it means to add. We are going to use the dice to find a number, collect that many objects, then roll again to find another number and find that many objects. Now we are going to count all of the objects together. How many do you have all together? Can you say the number equation that you have just worked out? For example, 3 add 2 is equals to 5.</p>	<p>Read these number equations:</p> <p>1 + 3 = 4 + 1 = 3 + 3 = 2 + 2 = 5 + 1 =</p> <p>Use objects or fingers to help you find the answers to the number equations.</p> <p>Challenge: can you write the answers in your exercise book?</p>	<p>Play a maths game! There are lots to choose from. Miss Kearns likes the Shape Patterns game! 

Use your playdough to create:

<p>Mindfulness/ Wellbeing</p>	<p>5 Senses</p> <p>Can you name: 5 things you can see 4 things you can feel 3 things you can hear 2 things you can smell 1 thing you can taste</p>	<p>Happiness Flower</p> <p>Can you draw a simple flower and fill the petals with things that make you feel happy??</p>	<p>Practise 'Take 5' Breathing</p> <p>Hold your hands out and spread your fingers. With the finger of the other hand, trace the outline of a finger breathing in through your nose as you trace up. Breathing out through your mouth as you trace down. Keep going at a steady pace.</p>	<p>Practise Star Breathing</p> <p>Start at a point on a star, follow your way around with your finger breathing slowly and holding your breaths at the points.</p> 	<p>One Minute Mindful Seeing</p> <p>Find a place where there are lots of things to see. For e.g. out of a window. For one minute, observe all the things you can see and make a list. Is there anything new that you've noticed that you haven't seen before?</p>
