



Describing something as being like something else that matches it, using the words:


- As... as a

similes

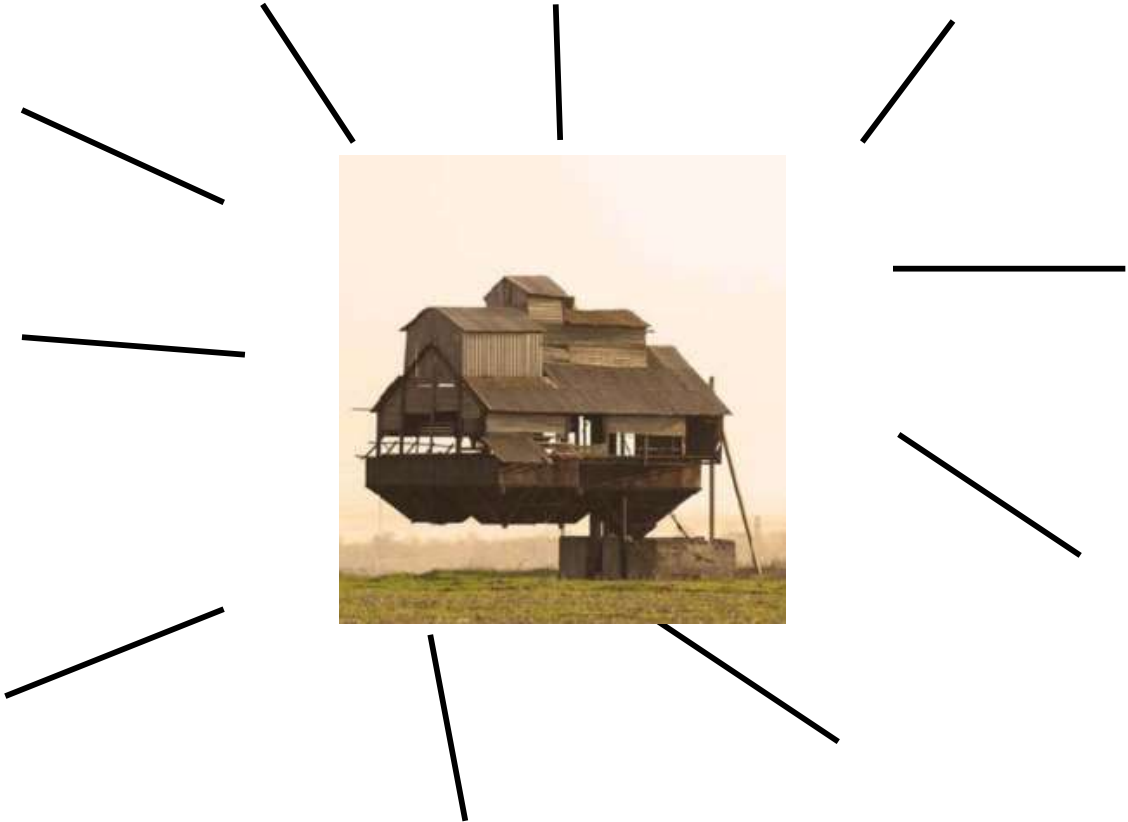
