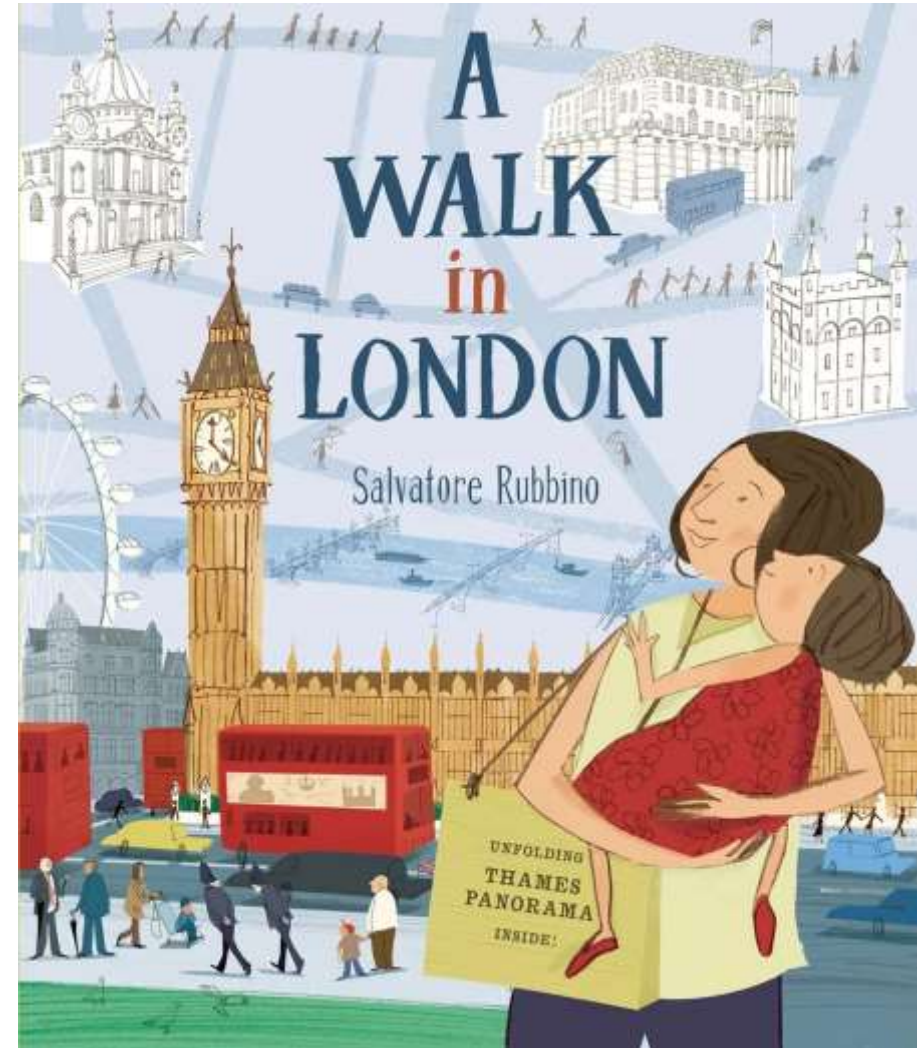


# A Walk In London







Four lions lie around the statue's base to guard it. They are made out of bronze which is kept shiny by all the visitors who come to sit on them.
