



Trafalgar Square is famous for the fountains and four lions.

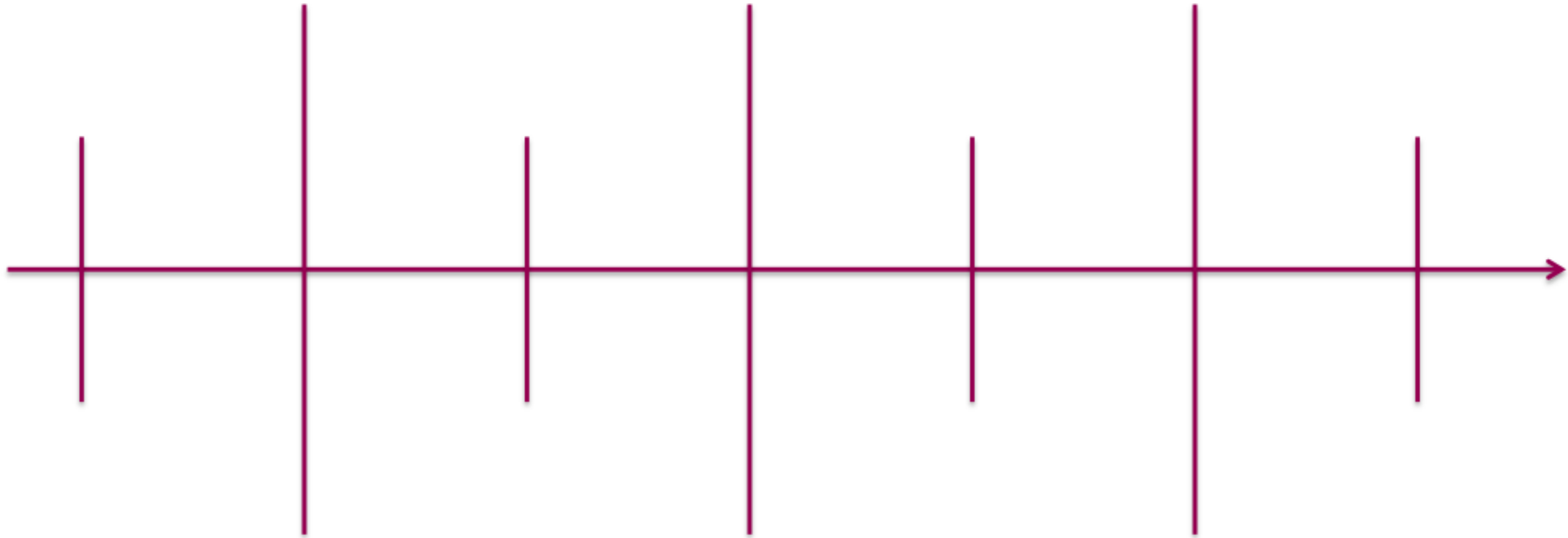
