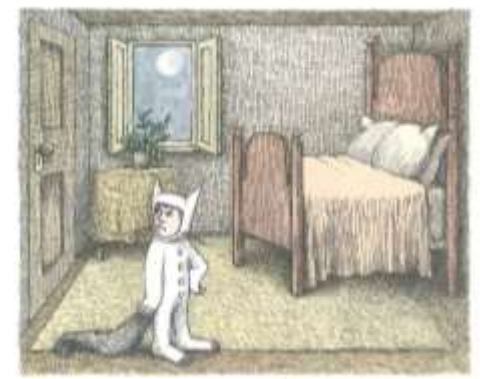


Year 1 – English – Lesson 9
