






With the finger of the other hand, trace the outline of a finger breathing in through your nose as you trace up. Breathing out through your mouth as you trace down. Keep going at a steady pace.</p>	<p>Practise Star Breathing</p> <p>Start at a point on a star, follow your way around with your finger breathing slowly and holding your breaths at the points.</p> 	<p>One Minute Mindful Seeing</p> <p>Find a place where there are lots of things to see. For e.g. out of a window. For one minute, observe all the things you can see and make a list. Is there anything new that you've noticed that you haven't seen before?</p>
