



Mindfulness/ Wellbeing	<p>5 Senses</p> <p>Can you name: 5 things you can see 4 things you can feel 3 things you can hear 2 things you can smell 1 thing you can taste</p>	<p>Happiness Flower</p> <p>Can you draw a simple flower and fill the petals with things that make you feel happy?</p>	<p>Practise 'Take 5' Breathing</p> <p>Hold your hands out and spread your fingers. With the finger of the other hand, trace the outline of a finger breathing in through your nose as you trace up. Breathing out through your mouth as you trace down. Keep going at a steady pace.</p>	<p>Practise Star Breathing</p> <p>Start at a point on a star, follow your way around with your finger breathing <i>slowly</i> and holding your breaths at the points.</p> 	<p>One Minute Mindful Seeing</p> <p>Find a place where there are lots of things to see. For e.g. out of a window. For one minute, observe all the things you can see and make a list. Is there anything new that you've noticed that you haven't seen before?</p>
