Watch Your Speed!

You many have noticed that new speed signs, indicating a speed limit of 20mph, have been placed on Dog Kennel Hill Road. These signs are part of a Speed Awareness Campaign, supported by DKH. As part of the campaign, Year 6 had a very special meeting with Will Norman, London Walking and Cycling Commissioner. They discussed how to reduce emissions by considering their journeys to and from school. Walking and cycling (we have a great bike shed for you to use - once Covid guidelines allow) are great ways to reduce our carbon footprint, however the journey must be a safe one. Speeding is the greatest deterrent and risk factor to children and adults walking and cycling more. To highlight this risk Year 6 worked with Road and Transport Police to use hand-held speed cameras to measure the speed of traffic on Dog Kennel Hill Road. It was an eye-opening and exciting experience, making children and drivers more aware of the importance of using our roads safely.

Mrs Cloete, Executive Head, also used this opportunity to highlight, again, our concern regarding the bus stop on Dog Kennel Hill Road and the potential risks it poses during staggered school entry. We are pleased to report that this will be followed up by the London Walking and Cycling Commissioner.

Winter Production


