<u>English</u>

Reading: This term in shared reading, we will be focusing on The Pig-Heart Boy by Malorie Blackman and The Wedding Ghost by Leon Garfield

Writing: This term, the children are focusing on The Wedding Ghost by Leon Garfield. By the end of the term they will have: written a character description; used dialogue; written a suspense piece and a descriptive scene. Grammar work through the story of The Wedding Ghost: Children will be learning how to write using the active and passive voice; and use more advanced punctuation e.g. colons and semi-colons.

Science


Animals Including Humans

PSHE <u>Celebrating Difference</u>
