

We are waiting for further information from the government regarding catch up programmes for children and when and how this will be implemented. We will update you once we have more information.


**EYFS have impressed us, once again, with their fantastic learning! Well done to all of the children from Nursery and Reception for your continued hard work and positive attitudes!**





Wonderful use of technology Jackie and you have shared an important message too!





Gabriel, in Cherry Class, has been working hard in maths and using his reasoning and problem-solving skills!
