- Talking about our families and communities
- Learning to confidently share our interests and opinions

**Physical Development: (PD)**

- Practicing pencil grip and control to begin to form some letters in our names
- Practicing dressing independently e.g. taking on/ off coat and shoes.
- Uses simple tools to effect changes to materials.
- Able to talk confidently about how we can keep healthy and safe.

**Communication and Language: (C&L)**

- Being able to listen and respond to ideas expressed by others in a conversation or discussion.
- Being able to follow instructions involving a two-part sequence.
- Beginning to anticipate and talk about key events in stories and share their own ideas about characters, plot, story structure etc.

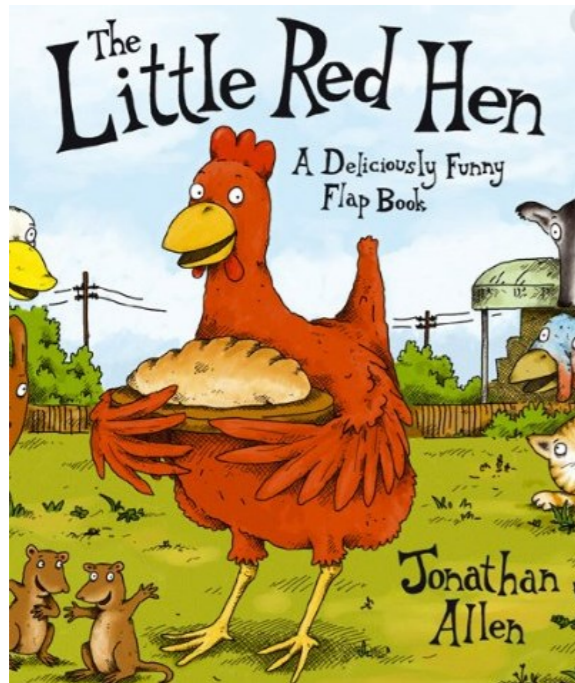
**Literacy: (L)**

- Designing wanted posters using adjectives to describe
- Making our own story maps and using them to retell the story using story book language
- Recipe writing
- Letter writing
- Using drama to retell the story
- Speech bubble/caption writing
- Sound of the week

**Maths: (M)**

- Exploring numbers 1-10
- Sorting, ordering items
- Recognising numerals in our environment
- Exploring positional language
- Recording number
- Identifying shapes and looking for shapes in the environment
