


Planning Grid - Year 2 - Spring 2021

- Working on descriptive language and the use of adventurous vocabulary

Numeracy

- To know the number of hours in one day
- To know that there are 60 minutes in one hour
- To be able to tell the time quarter past or to on an analogue clock
- To be able to tell the time on an analogue clock with five minute intervals
- To be able to sequence daily events
- To calculate durations of time in minutes and hours
- Relate halves and quarters to division
- Identify the parts of a fraction
- Identify half of a shape, halves, thirds and quarters of shape
- Identify non unit fractions of quantity and shape
- Identify equivalent fractions
