Book Focus: Stone Age Boy

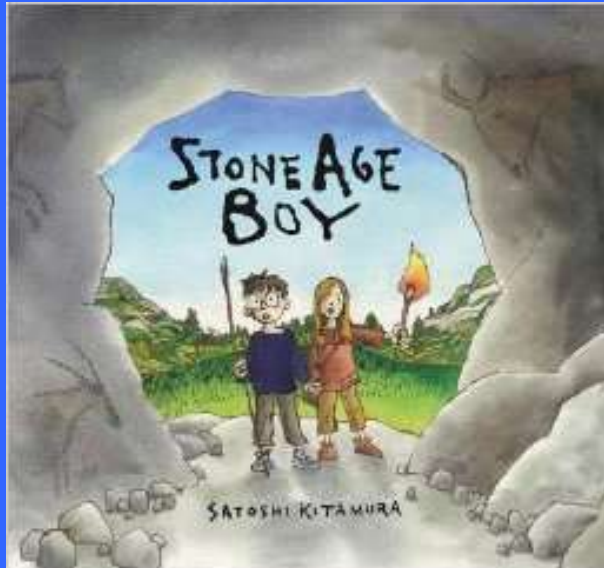
- To write in the first person.

Multiplication and Division

- Multiplication and division facts for 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 10
- Multiplicative structures: equal groups/parts, change and comparison, correspondence problems
- Relationships: commutativity and inverse
- Deriving multiplication and division facts Multiply and divide by 10 and 100
- Multiply a 2-digit number by 2, 3, 4, 5 and corresponding division situations
- Divide 2-digit by a 1-digit

Science (Light and Darkness)

Physics: Light and Darkness

- Recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light.
- Notice that light is reflected from surfaces.
- Recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes.
- Recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object find patterns in the way that the size of shadows change.
