<b>History / Geography</b>	<p><b>Crossing the Seas</b> This unit builds the children's understanding of migration – how some can be forced from their homelands while others have chosen to leave. This unit encompasses the Transatlantic Slave Trade, Britain's changing attitudes to immigration and the impact of immigrants on British culture.</p>		<p><b>World War 2</b> Using primary and secondary sources, we investigate what life was like for families in wartime London, including how experience was different based on age, gender and race.</p>		<p><b>The Mayans</b> In this unit, the children would be taught about a non-European society that provides contrasts with British history. This is a cross-curricular unit, taking in Mayan food, clothing and hairstyles (DT), the number system (maths) and creation myths (RE).</p>
