Dear Parents and Carers.

It was great to see children in their odd socks on Monday in support of Anti-Bullying Week. As part of Anti-bullying Week, our whole school assembly discussed what bullying is: The **repetitive**, **intentional hurting** of one person or group by another person or group, where the relationship involves an **imbalance of power**. Bullying can be physical, verbal or psychological. We discussed that bullying can happen face to face or online.

We also defined banter as: The playful and friendly exchange of teasing remarks. We said it is NOT banter if:

- 1. You would be upset if someone said it to you
- 2. It's hurtful
- 3. You're not friends
- 4. Someone's asked you to stop
- 5. The target isn't laughing
- 6. It focuses on someone's insecurities

Children were able to identify who they could speak to if they were concerned that bullying was taking place and they were vocal in their stance that **Bullying is not welcome at DKH!**

While the result may not have been in our favour, I am incredibly proud of how well the team played. Their effort and teamwork was truly commendable. 
