History (The Stone Age)

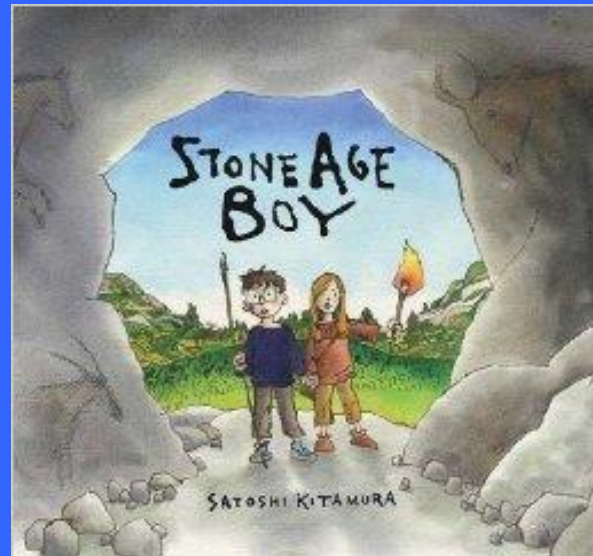
- To locate the Stone Age on a timeline
