3-D work

Children to use junk modelling to make 'traps' and 'jails' for the evil pea. How does your trap work?

Textiles and texture

Children to make their own potato superhero using a variety of tools and techniques.
Children to think carefully about the different materials they could use and for what effect



Printing

Children to learn about Andy Warhol and look at some of his work. Children to make to use of repetitive patterns and inspiration from the artist and print with vegetables.



3-D work

Children to make their own junk model egg 'home'. How can we keep the egg safe? What materials do we need to use?

Painting

Children to use oil pastels to draw our hatched chicks. Focus on how to create texture with the pastels and looking closely at the chicks different parts to draw them accurately.

Learn about carnivals around the world. Have opportunities to listen to live music. Have opportunities to listen to recorded music respond to picture instrument cards to follow directions – to tap, scrape, shake learn to describe sounds using onomatopoeia learn to sing a wider repertoire of songs
