Walk to School Week

Monday 20th May to Friday 24th May is walk to school week. Southwark Council are running a walk to school diary competition, with the school completing the most diary entries winning a prize. All children who complete a diary will also receive a certificate. Through this challenge, children will be well on their way to reaching their recommended 60 minutes minimum of physical activity per day before even reaching the school gates! Last year, over 750 schools across the UK took part! Help us make 2024 the biggest year yet!


We will be speaking to all the children about the competition in class and in Monday's assembly. If your child would like to take part in the competition, then they can get a 'walk to school diary' to complete from their class teacher. Those taking part will need to write about walking to school each day. Things that children could write in the diary could include:

- How many cyclists did you see on the road?
- How many children did you notice walking to school?
- What did you enjoy about your journey to school.
- What did you did you not enjoy about your journey to school.
- Improvements <u>you</u> would make to the road/street in order to make your journey safer and healthier.

Our Curriculum

The Relationship, Sex and Health Education (RSE) curriculum became statutory inSeptember 2020. Relationships and SexEducation supports and guides children andyoung people in lifelong learning about relationships, emotions, the human biologyof sex and sexuality. It is compulsory for allprimary school children to receive relationship education. At DKH we follow the Christopher Winter's Project. You can also:

- contact Southwark Antisocial Behaviour Unit by telephone 020 7525
- call Southwark Police on 101 (24 hours), or you can report it online
- contact your landlord, as they also have powers to tackle antisocial behaviour if you're a tenant of a registered social landlord or housing association
- council tenant and homeowners can report antisocial behaviour directly to their resident services officer.
