English (Street Child/A Christmas Carol)

Children will be using a range of grammatical skills in order to achieve these objectives:

- To make inferences about text and use evidence to support ideas
 - To use drama to help plan writing
 - To write a diary entry
 - To write a metaphor poem
 - To write a discursive argument
 - To write a letter

Geography (What is life like in The Alps?)

- To consider the climate of mountain ranges and why people choose to visit the Alps.
- To study Innsbruck and look at the human and physical features that attract tourists.
- To investigate tourism in the local area and map recreational land use.
- To present findings to compare the Alps to the children's own locality

PSHE (Celebrating Differences)

- Circle time sessions on how to solve problems successfully
- We will be looking at the following topics:

Children will be learning the following topics using the Maths Mastery curriculum.

Science (Properties and Changes of Materials)

We will be looking at the following questions:

- Investigate changes of state
- Compare and group together everyday materials on the basis of their properties and reason uses for particular materials
- Use knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaporating
- To understand that that some materials will dissolve in liquid to form a solution, and describe how to recover a substance from a solution through evaporation

RE (Christmas)

We will be looking at the following questions:

- What differences are there in accounts given by Luke and Matthew?
- Which stories have developed from the 'real' Christmas story?
 - What happens during Advent?
 - How do Christmas traditions vary around the world?
- What is Epiphany? How is Epiphany celebrated around the world?
- What story or play can we create based on traditional Christmas themes?
