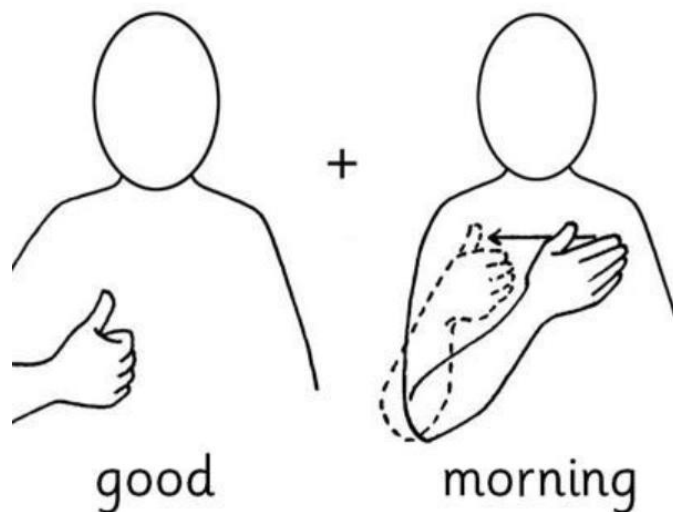
Club Donations

Grove Primary School Entrance

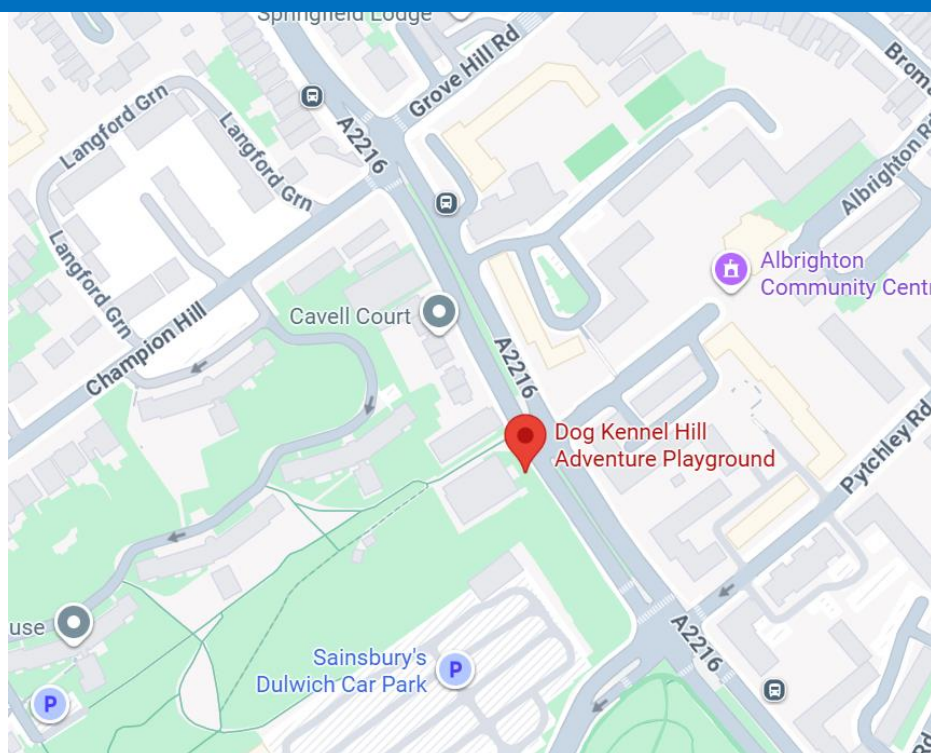
