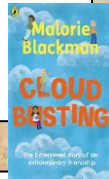

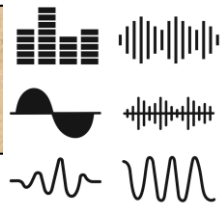

- Recognise that sounds get fainter as the distance from the sound source increases.



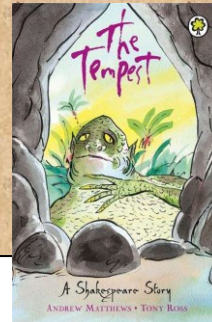
